



## OUR VISION & MISSION





**Our vision & mission is to create institutions dedicated to** nurturing and empowering women by providing them with opportunities to excel in both religious and academic knowledge. Through the guidance of the Quran and Sunnah, we aim to shape individuals into exemplary role models with exceptional character, rooted in faith and values. These institutions will serve as a beacon of learning and transformation, enabling women to become confident contributors to their families, communities, and society at large, as well as active participants in the establishment and propagation of Deen worldwide.



## OUR HISTORY-IN BRIEF

Originally founded in <u>1985</u> in Arabi, a suburb of New Orleans, Louisiana, The Islamic Association of Arabi is a nonprofit 501(c)(3) organization that began as a small masjid, Masjid Yaseen. Within five years, the first boarding Islamic institute in the United States was established under its management. From <u>1990</u> to <u>2005</u>, sixty-five American-born Muslim children completed the memorization of the Holy Quran, and twenty-one of these students went on to become Scholars of Islam. Today, Alhamdulillah, it is a source of immense pride that these graduates of The Islamic Association of Arabi are serving communities and masjids across the nation.

In August 2005, by the wisdom of Allah, Hurricane Katrina destroyed the Masjid and Islamic Institute in Arabi. This led to the dispersal of the local Muslim community across the country. Consequently, a decision was made to re-establish Masjid Yaseen and the Islamic Institute in the Dallas metropolitan area. Through Allah's grace, a 1.5-acre parcel of land was purchased in Garland, Texas (~20 miles northeast of Dallas) at the intersection of George W. Bush Tollway and W. Campbell Rd. Construction began in Ramadan 2008, and by mid-2011, the Masjid was completed, Alhamdulillah.

Alhamdulillah, due to the overwhelming demand for a full-time Hifz program for female students, in <u>2015</u>, the Association purchased a 6,300square-foot building in Garland, Texas. This facility is one of the first stand-alone buildings in the United States exclusively dedicated to the education and social development of Muslim girls and women.

In <u>2023</u>, a rental facility was added to accommodate Pre-Hifz and Hifz students. Looking ahead, our mission is to establish a new Islamic complex and youth center in the Dallas-Fort Worth area. This year, <u>2025</u>, we are actively raising funds for the acquisition of a new building that will serve as the cornerstone for this vision.

We humbly request your generous support to help us invest in the future of our children and community. Together, we can create an enduring legacy for the next generation of Muslim youth girls.

#### **Islamic Essentials of Teens**

This program is ideal for teenage Muslimah who want to learn the basics of their Deen and improve their connection with Allah. This 2-year program can also serve as the first year of our Alimah Course, in case the student is interested in studying further, InshaAllah. **Monday-Friday** Hours: 7:45am-2;00pm Ages: 11+ years

### **IAA Academics**

A program exclusively designed for full-time Hifdh students. The curriculum is carefully structured to provide quality education that aligns with state standards.








Currently, we have 228 students and 64 full-time & part-time female teachers & employees.




